

The Standards Australia technical advisory committee is responsible for developing the standards and incorporating feedback from stakeholders. After the standards are released, what is the process if there is a need to update and improve adopted standards in the future?

Any member of the public or organisation can propose changes at any time. Work on any amendment or revision would start subject to that proposal meeting our quality requirements, and the proposal being broadly supported by stakeholders.

2. How does Standards Australia determine which stakeholders will comprise a technical committee? How did organisations obtain representation on this particular Technical Advisory Committee?

The process for constituting technical committees is set out in our Standardisation Guide – *SG-002: Structure and Operation of Standardisation Committees* in particular sections 5, 6 and 7.
