Monitoring of criminal offences

Rather than relying on maritime and aviation security card holders to self-report that they have been found guilty of a disqualifying offence, or for the two-year renewal period to elapse, are there any technical or legal barriers to the ACIC regularly—that is, on a weekly or daily basis—matching lists of convictions against lists of card holders to enable cards to be promptly withdrawn?

From Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission:

There are both technical and legal barriers for the ACIC to perform continuous criminal conviction checking on a more regular basis.
