Dear Senator Birmingham

Thank you for your letter of 29 October 2009 to the former Premier of NSW, the Hon Nathan Rees MP, requesting information on water licences and water rights. Your letter has been referred to me as the information sought falls within my area of responsibility.

With regard to the progress with the National Water Initiative, the recent report by the National Water Commission "*Australian Water Reform 2009: Second biennial assessment of progress in implementation of the National Water Initiative*" broadly outlines that progress. More specifically, the following information is provided:

1. *conversion of water licences to separate tradable entitlements*

NSW leads the way in the separation of land and water entitlements. This separation occurs as statutory water sharing plans are developed for a water source. As 90 per cent of water extraction in NSW is now covered by water sharing plans, the most significant areas of water extraction in NSW have had their licences separated and these licences are fully tradable.

## 2. *water planning*

In number terms, NSW has now completed 45 of its expected 82 water sharing plans, but in terms of water extraction NSW's completed plans cover over 90 per cent of water extraction. NSW has focused its efforts on the more intensive high priority water sources. Progress on development of the water sharing plans was delayed by the Commonwealth's *Water Act 2007* and the uncertainty around the proposed Basin Plan, and how this would impact on NSW's plans. It is now intended to complete all inland water sharing plans by 2011, and the remaining coastal plans by 2012.

## 3. *integration of planning and management of surface water and groundwater*

NSW does integrate the planning and management of surface water and groundwater systems where these are interconnected. A number of water sharing plans have and will continue to be developed, combining surface and groundwater management and water sharing rules.

## 4. *integration of planning and management of entitlement water and other water-intercepting landuses*

NSW has a farm dams policy which limits the amount of water that can be captured without a licence. In addition, NSW is finalising a floodplain harvesting policy which will not only licence floodplain harvesting activities, but make them subject to volume limits. This will bring the last major extraction activity in NSW within the formal water entitlements framework. NSW is also developing guidelines to place limits on extraction of water via basic landholder rights.

## 5. *facilitate water trading, including interstate water trading*

NSW has the most expansive and robust water trading system in the nation, as evidenced by the significant trading that has occurred over the last few years despite severe drought and limited water availability. NSW has met every requirement under the National Water Initiative to facilitate trade, including inter-state trade. NSW signed inter-state trading arrangements with Victoria and South Australia in 2007.

## 6. *water accounting and metering*

NSW has been actively involved with the Bureau of Meteorology in the development of the national framework and standards for water accounting and has undertaken a pilot project in the Murrumbidgee.

Most water users in the regulated rivers and the major inland groundwater aquifers in NSW are metered. Funding has been secured from the Commonwealth for a metering program in the Hawkesbury-Nepean River, and in-principle approval has been received for funding metering across the Murray-Darling Basin covering regulated rivers, unregulated rivers and

groundwater. The Murray-Darling Basin metering project, however, will be dependent on the due diligence assessment by the Commonwealth of a business case for the project.

The following attachments provide information on water licences and entitlements in NSW. Note that water licences in NSW are currently managed under two pieces of legislation – the *Water Act 1912* - and for those areas covered by water sharing plans – the *Water Management Act 2000*. Most water extraction is now covered by water sharing plans and is therefore licensed under the *Water Management Act 2000*.

A definition by the Committee of sleeper licences (i.e. no extraction over a specifically defined period) would be required for the NSW Office of Water to assess the number of these licences and, obviously, this assessment can only be made for those water sources where extractions are largely metered, which is in regulated rivers and inland groundwater aquifers. However, given the growth in water trade there would be few licences which have not used or traded their account water in the regulated river systems in recent years.

A similar position would be likely with the major groundwater systems where entitlements were recently reduced to the sustainable yield and the history of extractions taken into account in this process. With unregulated river systems, as flows are more opportunistic, there may be a higher component of unused licences, however when unregulated river licences were converted to a volume basis, inactive licences were given a lower conversion volume.

I hope this information is of assistance to your Committee.
