I would like to say that how this bill would affect the life of people who are in love relationship (from different country and religion) while living in Australia on temporary visas and waiting for PR decision if this bill is passed. I'm an Indian (finished study in Australia and have applied application for PR in April) and my girl friend is Chinese (on temporary work visa after finishing one year study in Australia). I met with my girl friend about one and half year ago and since then we are in love. Because of our culture and conservative parent's thinking, we are even unable to inform our parents about our relationship as it is unlikely our parents on both sides accept this relationship or our marriage.

If this bill terminates my PR application, then I have to go back my country, and I'm afraid my parents will force me to marry another Indian girl (arrange marriage) which they have already selected for me and I'm already under pressure from my parents to come back India and get married with that girl.

I love my girl friend and we are in living relationships now, and planning to marry next year in Australia. So Please I request Australian Government to save our life, don't just terminate my PR application and force me to leave country in 28 days with no option I can appeal against it.
