Question: Could you outline the timeframe for the recommissioning of the Curtin Detention

centre?

Answer: On 18 April 2010, the Government announced that the RAAF Base Curtin facility would

be used to accommodate IMAs.

On 12 June 2010, following various works programs the Curtin detention centre had its

first intake of IMA clients.

In September 2010, following additional work the capacity increased to 600 clients.

On 17 September 2010, Minister Bowen announced that the capacity of the Curtin detention facility would be increased to 1200 clients. Following additional work this

additional capacity became available on 23 December 2010.
