Hi Pothida,

One of the questions on notice for UCNSW and AFUO was “In terms of Russian oil coming from third countries, have you been able to estimate how much oil is coming into Australia and what impact that would be having on fuel supplies ?”

I note that neither the UCNSW nor AFUO has the capability to estimate this confidently. We asked CREA for their guidance, and they responded that “*In 2025, Australia imported 6.3 mn tonnes of refined oil products from third country refineries using Russian crude. An estimated 2.6 mn of this was refined from Russian crude.*”

If you require further information I would suggest contacting CREA directly.
