



Credit Suisse to appear before foreign investment inquiry in Canberra

The House of Representatives Economics Committee is holding its sixth public hearing for the inquiry into foreign investment in residential real estate in Canberra on Wednesday 24 September 2014.

The Committee will hear from Credit Suisse who have analysed the levels of investment from China in Australia's property market.

The Chair of the Committee, Ms Kelly O'Dwyer MP, said that 'Credit Suisse has conducted some interesting market analysis of current and future trends in foreign investment in real estate. This data is very relevant to this inquiry and the Committee looks forward to exploring the analysis further with Credit Suisse.'
