**Senator Kim Carr asked:**

Senator KIM CARR: How many breaches were there in 2020, of all the media outlets in Australia?  
Ms O'Loughlin: I don't believe I have that information in front of me at the moment. I'm looking at Cathy, who is also shaking her head.

Ms Rainsford: I'm afraid I don't have that information either, but we'd be happy to take it on notice.

**Answer:**

In 2020 the ACMA finalised 20 investigations that resulted in one or more breach findings against a broadcaster. These breaches are broken down by broadcaster type in [Table 1](#) below.

Investigations covered a range of matters covered by the relevant industry code of practice, not just news and current affairs.
