I believe this bill to not be fair to the Muckaty people. The area was not selected openly nor was it approved by the land's traditional owners. Making the bill coercive. To dump nuclear waste on Aboriginal land is wrong, as for one the majority of Aboriginal people are against mining uranium in the first place.

The selection of Muckaty does not appear to be based in reason, more in political gameplaying. The Muckaty area did not even make the shortlist as a suitable site in a report based on environmental science in the 1990s.
