Overview of ASIS's submission to the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security's *Review of Administration and Expenditure No. 17 (2017-18)*

Section 29 of the *Intelligence Services Act 2001* requires the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security (the Committee) to review the administration and expenditure, including the annual financial statements, of the intelligence agencies.

At the Committee's invitation, ASIS has made a classified submission addressing the terms of reference for the *Review of Administration and Expenditure No. 17 (2017-18)*.

ASIS's submission provides a detailed report concerning the Service's strategic direction, administration and governance, as well as details of its annual expenditure and overall financial position.
