Dear Senator Secretary,

In Verses 1, what we view with our eyes cover a warning about porn

Verses 2 and 3 teach and warn about being careful what we listen to and say - that would include gossip, hate speech and bullying.

Just BE CAREFUL. Which is a warning.

The essence of this song is that the warning is delivered in a loving way. When taught by parents, teachers or significant others the children can feel safe. Because without going into any graphic

detail adults know and kids know there are areas to be careful about. We know and we care.

Simply teaching this song in family or community gives an acknowledgement to potential dangers and issues thus providing a level of protection. The transparency of a strategy ie Singing a song out loud gives an extra level of protection and safety (quite profound and powerful)

The question is why "be careful"? Well the increase in data figures for particular related health and crime issues are telling the story.

Ironically Verses 1& 2 of this song addresses and encapsulates the solution for current issues such as #pornharmskids (Keep your mind away from hurtful addictive images and don't listen to those who want to tell you about such images). Children and many adults don't realize that what they see and hear will influence how they think and therefore how they act.

Singing such a song is one easy, effective key strategy for a solution to the current #pornharmskids issue and other related issues.

Ironically V3 BCLLWYSis the Original Anti-bullying program. The SayNO2Bullying Program. Teasing and gossip as the first signs of addictive bullying behaviour. Behaviour Management Programs etc.

A comprehensive Behaviour Management program is contained in these 3 verses. (Less is best curriculum) - short and sweet.

This song covers Influences on our mind (through senses)

Mind, thinking, thought processes will guide how we ultimately act. (totally Scriptural). See Dr Caroline Leaf Et al.

Hence Christian Schools were started.

I wonder how many children know this song now?

Would be great if a Video Graphics StartUp (or similar group) could use their God-given talents and technology of today to produce an up to date, version for this song for this generation to learn. Could be a short Advertisement style video.

Check if there are any copyright issues with the use of the song. Be wonderful if the song went "viral" and many, many, many children learnt the strategies for better, kinder behaviour from this

In school assembly halls in the national school grid (Government built school halls) and in All Independent and Private schools.

Prepare a set of matching videos to supplement the main thrust of "Being Careful" at the same time teaching children to be responsible for their own behaviour rather than a victim. Be responsible by being very careful to NOT go where you are being tempted to go!!! That sort of be careful. Be strong and say NO.

Use the series of linked video stories on Being careful with eyes ears and lips at key times of remembrance e.g. Christmas Easter, Remembrance Day, Anzac Day, Australia Day, Report Presentations and Formals. Thus teaching the children specifically about caring about themselves and how they stay away from addictions and unhealthy behaviours.

To have an audio- visual video broadcast for learning the song. There is a generation who has missed out on learning this song. Partner with a music group to produce the video.
