Notes:

- Microsoft Australia Pty Ltd is the core Sales & Marketing entity operating in Australia
- The entities of FAST, aQuantive and Amnesia have since been dissolved
- FY14 Revenue dissection for Microsoft Pty Ltd:
 - In the Senate Hearing we represented that the total sales billed to customers in Australia was approximately \$100m. This accurately reflects the local billings to "Australian customers" for consulting services provided in Australia by Microsoft Pty Ltd.
 - Other Revenue amounts recognised in our audited Financial Statements for Microsoft Pty Ltd include; **Commission income** received from Microsoft Singapore for marketing and sales support services, **Interest Income** and **FX (gains/losses)**. An example of the FY14 breakdown is as follows:
