Re Immigration – Visa Capping Bill

I would like to complain about the above and how unfair it could be on my daughter's visa application (which has already been submitted).

We have spent our entire savings on TAFE fees (\$30,000) skills assessments, health checks, immigration fees, transport, living expenses approximately \$50, 000. On a course that would entitle her to 60 points (Diploma of Community Welfare Work – with Distinction in most subjects). She is on-shore international student and has been in Australia for 3 ½ years.

You now you can change the rules retrospectively if this bill is introduced.

You must be able to see how unfair this would be on my daughter, my husband and myself.

Please reconsider!
