



Hearing for foreign investment inquiry in Melbourne

The House of Representatives Economics Committee will conduct its second public hearing for the inquiry into foreign investment in residential real estate in Melbourne on Friday 20 June 2014.

The Chair of the Committee, Ms Kelly O'Dwyer MP, said that 'the Committee is continuing its examination of the regulatory framework for foreign investment in residential property and whether it is delivering the best social and economic outcomes for Australia. We are also particularly interested in the trends and data that are available in relation to this type of investment.'

At this second public hearing for this inquiry, the committee will be hearing from the Property Council of Australia, various real estate companies that operate in Australia and overseas, and two of Australia's major financial institutions, ANZ and Macquarie Group.
