# **Question:**

Can the Treasury provide an estimate of additional expenditure on COVID-19 supports to businesses and households since the 2021-22 Budget was published?

#### Answer:

Since the 2021-22 Budget support has been provided to households through the COVID-19 Disaster Payment, and to businesses through agreements with states and territories. Data available as at 25 August indicates that the Commonwealth has provided around \$4.8 billion in additional support since the 2021-22 Budget.
