My name is James Brittain and I have been been trained in the Home Sustainability Assessment Program in December 2009, and am waiting to be advised if I have a contract with DEWHA. I have received my HO number which is HO55429 and I have received an ID card from ABSA. I have contacted DEWHA several times, and have spoken to personnel on several occasions trying to obtain information in relation to my registration with the program and when I will, or will I receive a contact with DEWHA. I have also tried to get confirmation that the signed contact has been received by DEWHA to no avail.

I have been a professional electrician for my entire working career with 28 years experience in the electrical industry and and have been deeply involved with a sustainability assessment program for over the last 1 1/2 years. Due to this experience, and a genuine interest in sustainability of homes and business, I believe that this puts me in an ideal position to supply a very comprehensive assessment of an installation and provide this in a professional and correct manner.

During the training in the HSA program I have had to pay a substantial amount of monies for training and insurances, not to mention the loss of wages whilst I was performing this training. Due to the changes in the program I have not received a contact to perform Assessments and this in turn has not given me the opportunity to to repay these outlays. The electrical industry is going through a down turn at the moment, and this as well as not knowing whether or not I will receive a contact with DEWHA has strained our family budgets a great deal.

I do believe that the contacts to supply the assessments should be reset, and contacts be offered to personnel that can show and prove that they are capable of suppling a comprehensive service to the program, that would meet the highest standard. I do also believe that offering the assessments to small businesses would be beneficial to both the program and to the customer of the assessment, in helping customers get some workable solutions to raising energy and water costs.
