I believe that the visa capping is unfair. If immigration was becoming unmanageable then steps should have been taken earlier so that GSM application is not made at first place.

1. It is unfair especially for those who have taken some decisions after lodging an application. Some of them are preparing for migration and have sold their houses and resigns from their jobs.
2. Some of them are already in Australia on alternative visa.
3. Its not just one person who is going to affect by capping but they are linked to their family, their family depends on them so if one application is capped at least four persons will be affected. Capping 1000 means affecting 4000 persons, which is huge.
4. Some persons shows fake documents (experience and education) and got visa because they are on CSL, where as genuine applicants who are not on CSL are trapped in priority waiting with indefinite wait.
5. Its not the Visa application charge which is around \$2100, cost of skill assessment near \$400 , cost of making certificates and attesting them around \$500. Cost paid to agent around \$2500 and most important the time the applicants are waiting, as we know time is money all those things should also be taken into account.
6. Australia reputation , person dreams and hopes could be shattered.

In my case my child is already in Australia on some alternative visa and already lodged an application since two years and waiting for decision.
