**Mr Stephen Jones, MP asked:**

**Mr STEPHEN JONES:** For HFC premises that don't have an existing lead in does the NBN try and run the coax through the existing conduit or is there another mechanism?

**Mr Ryan:** If a house doesn't have a lead in we have to build a conduit, unless there's an existing unused conduit, but that's pretty rare.

**Mr STEPHEN JONES:** That would take the diameter size.

**Mr Ryan:** Yes, exactly. We generally have to trench in, build the conduit and haul the coax cable through it. I think it's a 50, but we'll get that checked.
