The Aged Care Act 1997 is structured around providers and how to fund them - not about the people accessing services and what they need.

The Aged Care Bill 2024 focuses on older people and their care needs.

Once enacted, the Bill will deliver a rights-based aged care system, a new program to provide support for older people in their homes, strengthened Quality Standards, a new regulatory framework and a stronger regulator, and co-contributions to make the Australian aged care system fair and sustainable into the future.
