

I can advise the following in relation to the Question on Notice:

Veda's relevant business reporting services involve the collection of information regarding businesses from various sources, which is collated and analysed in reports on request by customers. Whilst those reports typically contain information regarding credit risk, they would not in the ordinary course identify criminal conduct. In the event that Veda does become aware of such conduct, it would comply with its legal obligations in this regard. Where Veda has a legal obligation to report a matter to the police, it would do so directly.
