Question:

I understand the Government has contracted ASPEN Medical to supply regional and remote aged care workforce. Has anyone from ASPEN Medical been deployed to regional and remote facilities? If so, to which facilities?

Answer:

Aspen Medical Emergency Response Teams have been deployed to five aged care services in regional Australia (based on the ABS Geography Standard Remoteness Structure).

The Department of Health would prefer not to name the facilities due to the impact public disclosure has on services, their staff and residents due to media exposure as well as their continued ability to operate. We want to encourage service providers to proactively report cases to the Department.
