Regarding - Native Vegetation Laws, Greenhouse Gas Abatement and Climate Change Measures

Submission -

The impact of native vegetation laws as it stands affects the ability to abate greenhouse gases by landowners who,

- (a) Allow land to be used for purposes other than the survival of native vegetative;
- (b) Since receive under-compensation for land that has been used for such purposes; and
- (c) Are benefactors on asset value calculation when land has be used for purposes the legislation deems as beneficial.
- (d) Further attention is bought to land that has been used for the cultivation of marijuana, ephedra, sassafras, cocaine and opium which has subsequently been improperly valued for reasons of law.
