Re: Additional material for Inquiry into the Clean Energy Finance Corporation Amendment (Grid Reliability Fund) Bill 2020

At the public hearing in Canberra on Tuesday, 13 October 2020, The Australia Institute undertook to provide additional material to the committee **regarding any decisions and/or documents provided to us under FOI in relation to the UNGI program.**

On close inspection our research on the UNGI program has been primarily informed by Senate Estimates (outlined in The Australia Institute's [Problems with UNGI](#) briefing note that has already been tabled) and on FOI requests undertaken by other organisations.
