Senator Sarah Hanson-Young asked:

I understand that the department has recently or is currently conducting consultations with industry and stakeholders in relation to local content quotas for streaming platforms. Would the department please provide copies of materials provided to stakeholder/s for the purpose of consultation, including any modelling of local content quota requirements or various models of potential local content requirements?

Answer:

On 24 March 2023, a *Targeted Stakeholder Consultation Paper – Australian screen content obligations on streaming services* and a *Consultation response form* were sent to a group of stakeholders in confidence seeking written responses by 28 April 2023, extended to 4 May 2023. Minor revisions were made to the consultation paper in an email issued to stakeholders on 28 March 2023.

The Government intends to respect the good faith of stakeholders in providing the document in confidence until the conclusion of the consultation process.
