I would just like to say that as a volunteer firefighter with the Victorian CFA with some 25 years experience that we have to do something about climate change. It is so easy to see the difference a few degrees makes between a hot and a mild summers day to the fire density index and the severity of fires and the difficulties the community find in coping. If climate change is allowed to proceed and we have summers another three degrees hotter then that will really be an extreme situation.

Let's get cracking and really do something to clean up our act and genuinely aim to hand on a livable future for our children.
