Will Thriving Kids have the authority to independently investigate and respond to bullying perpetrated by authority figures such as teachers and health professionals involved? bullying is a well studied contributor and compounding factor regarding children with developmental delay. The NDIS has safeguards in theory at least but there doesn't seem to be -what is described in the literature as child abuse and neglect- any safeguards against child abuse. Existing mechanisms and bully identification by teachers is currently insufficient because they won't self-identify for obvious reasons.
