I started student with Zero account but I felt good because I came to know as long as I truly strive they will give me another opportunity.

I have spent for more than 5years and I never cheated anyone, never bludged in any work and never harmed or hurt anybody.  
I thought Australia is a fair country and this is the motive power I could endure the hard farm work.  
But now all the money I spent for the school tuition fee, all the hard work I did for 5years in Australia: however which I enjoyed at the same time, all the time and money are probably about to go in vain.

Please generously bend an ear to what I say; I strongly am making a request to reconsider the new bill for all of us.
