**Topic: Fixed wireless towers in national parks**

**Ms Susan Templeman, MP asked:**

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Just to cover off fixed wireless, do you have the data on the number of fixed wireless towers that have been placed in national parks around the country, with a state-by-state breakdown? Are you able to get that data?

**Mr Ryan:** We would have, but not at hand.

**Mr Rue:** I'm sure we have that. We will get that for you. We'll take that on notice.

**Answer:**

As of August 2018, nbn has 10 sites in operation in National Park lands across Australia. All these sites are co-locating on existing structures. The breakdown by state is as follows: six in Queensland, one in New South Wales, two in Victoria and one in Western Australia.
