I hope that the Committee will except this additional paragraph submitted in relation to the Foreign Incursion aspect of Schedule 1 of the Bill:

The "legitimate purpose" exceptions to the declared area offence are obviously inadequate. For instance, they do not encompass vists to friends, for academic or other research purposes, for commercial purposes, or any of the other myriad ways in which many people in conflict zones attempt to carry on ordinary life. The framing of these exceptions as defences requiring the discharge of an evidential burden also unfairly prejudices potential defendants - typically discharging an evidential burden will require the accused to lead evidence, thereby waiving the right to remain silent in the fact of charges against him or her.
