



# Radiology Services Profile

**2016-17**



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## Executive Summary

The Radiology Services Profile provides an annual overview of medical imaging service performance across all Hospital and Health Services (HHSs) through the completion of a data collection survey by each medical imaging facility. Data is presented by financial year with comparisons to previous years where relevant.

The number of facilities providing medical imaging services during the 2016-17 financial year increased to 129<sup>1</sup> from 128 facilities in the previous financial year. The additional medical imaging facility arose from the opening of the Sunshine Coast University Hospital (SCUH) in March 2017.

Across Queensland Health medical imaging sites there has been a 4.7% increase in medical imaging examinations over the past year with over 2.3 million examinations performed in 2016-17.

The average reporting rate (percentage of examinations reported) increased to 99% and continues to be above the 90% target<sup>2</sup> except at one remote site, where the reporting rate was 88%.

Service delivery models remained unchanged: the total number of facilities operating a fully outsourced model remains at 11. With the opening of SCUH there are now 11 facilities that operate a public service delivery model (up from 10) and there remain 107 sites using a partial outsource model, where some or all radiologist services are performed through a private partnership.

15 of the 16 HHSs utilise a private partnership for some or all of their radiology reporting (down from 16 in 2015-16). The percentage of outsourced reports has decreased from 44% in 2015-16 to 42% in 2016-17. 389, 089 (40%) of outsourced reports were delivered to QH facilities electronically via the External Radiology Reporting Interface (ERRI).<sup>3</sup>

The total combined funded FTEs<sup>4</sup> for 2016-17 was 1,833. This figure represents an increase of 11.2% when compared to the 2015-16 financial year.

There were a total of 89 FTE vacancies, an 18% increase on the previous year. This represents a vacancy rate for the 2016-17 financial year of 4.8%.

91 of the 129 medical imaging sites (71%) are wholly or partially supported in general x-ray acquisition by hospital employed x-ray operators.<sup>5</sup>

The number of facilities providing ultrasound services remained at 52. Within the Sunshine Coast HHS, ultrasound services commenced at SCUH whilst ceasing at Caloundra.

In 2016-17 CT services commenced at Gympie, RBWH NM and SCUH while they ceased at Caloundra. This brings the total number of facilities providing CT to 34.

In 2016-17, the average number of business days to the next available appointment increased across all modalities except Angiography / Interventional:

- CT increased from 5 to 7 days
- Fluoroscopy increased from 7 to 10 days
- MRI increased from 19 to 24 days
- Ultrasound (excluding obstetrics) increased from 9 to 10 days

Note that there are different Radiology Information Systems in use across the state and these may not count examinations (or attendances) in a consistent manner.

## **Introduction**

The Radiology Services Profile provides an overview of medical imaging service performance across all HHSs. Data is collected via a manual process that involves completion of a data collection form (Appendix 1) for each medical imaging facility. The information is collated and analysed by Radiology Support, Biomedical Technology Services (BTS), Health Support Queensland (HSQ).

Data is presented by financial year with data going back to 2012-13.

## **Data collection survey**

The data collection survey is normally reviewed annually in consultation with the Medical Imaging Directors Association Queensland (MIDAQ), however owing to time constraints, a review was not undertaken prior to the 2016-17 annual data collection.

## **Significant events**

In regards to medical imaging, there were no significant events during the 2016-17 financial year

## Summary of results

### Workload

In 2016-17, 2.3 million medical imaging examinations were provided by 129 Queensland Health and Mater Public facilities utilising 782 equipment units. There has been a 4.7% increase in medical imaging examinations over the past year with an overall increase of 22.8% since 2012-13.

For the second year running there were no examinations recorded at Croydon, a rural and remote facility located in Cairns and Hinterland HHS.

### Workload by modality

In 2016-17 there were increases greater than 10% in the number of examinations performed within the following modalities: Angio/Interventional and MRI, as seen in Table 1. Decreases greater than 10% were noted for Cardiac, Fluoro/Special Procedures and Other Modalities.

- Numbers for PET CT and PET MR were for the first time collected separately, whereas previously they were included within Other Modalities - thus there was a 68.9% decrease in Other Modalities.
- Numbers for Cardiac are reduced because Nambour, Toowoomba and Townsville did not include data for cardiac examinations in the 2016-17 financial year, whereas they did in previous years.
- Numbers for Fluoroscopy/Special Procedures have decreased because PAH and Caboolture did not include data for Fluoroscopy/Special Procedures examinations in the 2016-17 financial year and because there was a significant reduction in numbers at Nambour (1,254 in 2015-16 to 441 in 2016-17).

The highest proportion of examinations performed by modality was general x-ray with 1,325,878 examinations which accounted for 57.4% of the total examinations performed (see Table 2).

CT was the second highest proportion of the examinations with 410,168 CT examinations performed, representing 17.8% of the total. Additional CT services commenced at Gympie, RBWH Nuclear Medicine and SCUH, whilst CT services at Caloundra ceased as of 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017, bringing the total number of facilities providing CT to 34.

Ultrasound was the third highest proportion of the examinations, with 316,833 ultrasound examinations performed, representing 13.7% of the total. In 2016-17 the provision of ultrasound services commenced at SCUH whilst ultrasound services ceased at Caloundra. Accordingly the total number of sites offering an ultrasound service remained at 52.

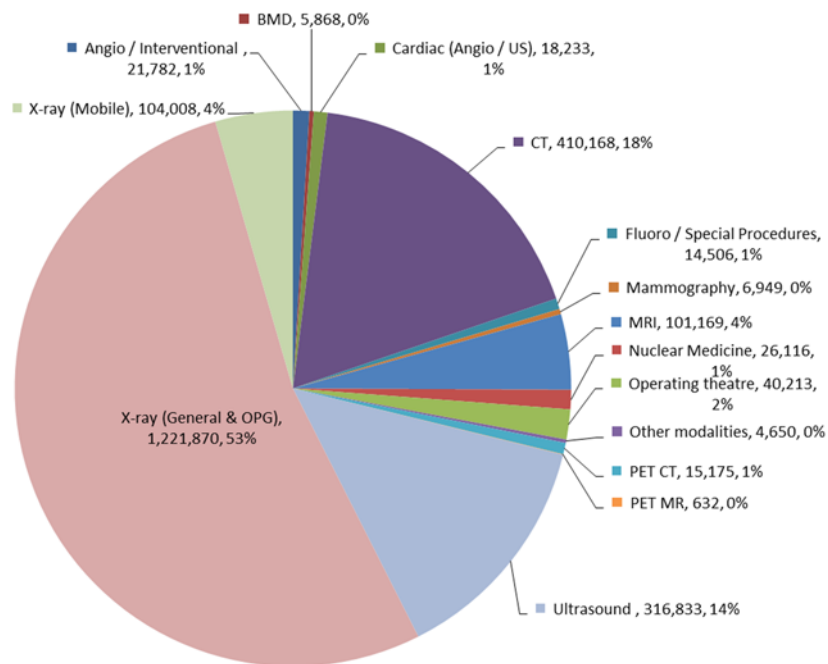


Figure 1 Medical imaging examination by modality

## Workload by HHS

Nearly all HHSs experienced an increase in workload – the exceptions were Central West HHS (decrease of 2.3%), Metro South HHS (decrease of 0.7%) and North West HHS (decrease of 19.8%).

Within Central West HHS the 2.3% decrease in examination numbers is largely attributable to a 8% reduction in the number of examinations at Longreach.

The decrease in examinations within Metro South may be attributable to the introduction of multi-region codes following the implementation of the ieMR. During the 2016-17 year, changes were made to the method of counting examinations within the ieMR to support and encourage the endorsement of exam reports which has resulted in a reduction of examination numbers at ieMR sites, including a 5% reduction at the PAH, the largest of the metropolitan hospitals within the Metro South HHS.

Within North West HHS there was a reduction in numbers at all sites except Normanton and Mornington Island. The largest impact on HHS examination numbers was attributable to a 21% decrease in examination numbers at Mt. Isa.

Two HHSs experienced an increase in examination numbers that were just above 10% (Darling Downs and Mackay) whilst South West HHS experienced an increase of 45.3%.

Within Darling Downs HHS there were dramatic increases in examination numbers at Goondiwindi (119% increase), Jandowae (126% increase) and Warwick (77% increase). The increases seen at Goondiwindi and Warwick are largely attributable to the inclusion of private patient examinations which were excluded in the previous financial year.

Within Mackay HHS there were increases above 10% at the following sites: Bowen (15% increase), Collinsville (17% increase), Dysart (72% increase) and Mackay (12% increase). Of these, Mackay and Bowen had the largest impact on examination numbers within the Mackay HHS.

The 45.3% increase in examinations within South West HHS, can largely be attributed to a 133% increase in the number of examinations performed at Roma Hospital. This large increase in numbers is due to the inclusion of all private outpatient examinations – the proportion of private examinations at Roma increasing from 7% to 49%. There was also a 69% increase in the number of examinations performed at Mitchell, a 34% increase at Augathella and a 32% increase at Dirranbandi, but as these are all x-ray operator sites with relatively low throughput of patients, these increases have not manifested in a great change to the number of examinations performed within South West HHS as a whole.

Note that there are different Radiology Information Systems in use across the state and these may not count examinations (or attendances) in a consistent manner.

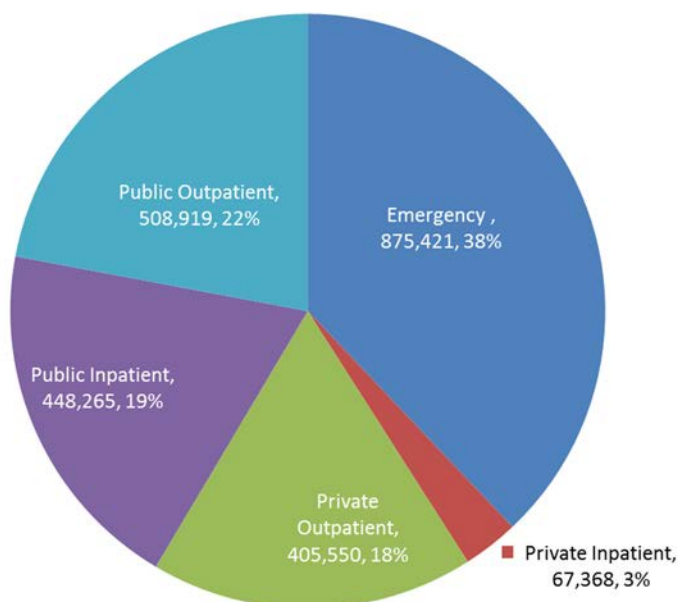

### Workload by patient type

A breakdown of workload by patient type shows that 38% of patients are referred by emergency departments, 40% are outpatients and 22% are inpatients.

The data represented in Figure 2 shows the combined data from all sites able to provide a breakdown of patient type.<sup>6</sup>

Table 4 shows a similar percentage of private patient examinations compared to previous years. A more detailed breakdown can be seen in Appendix 6.

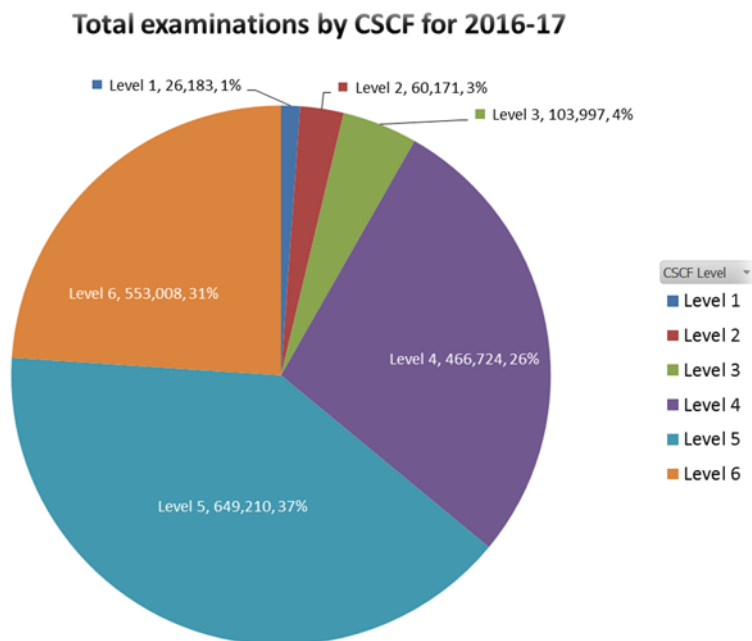
#### Workload by Clinical Services Capability Framework level

The Clinical Services Capability Framework (CSCF) includes 6 levels for medical imaging with level 1 managing the least complex patients and level 6 managing the highest level of patient complexity.

Level 5 facilities continue to perform the highest percentage of the combined workload with 649,210 examinations performed (37% of the total).

### Service delivery models

In terms of service delivery model, the total number of facilities operating a fully outsourced model remains at 11. With the opening of SCUH there are now 11 facilities that operate a public service delivery model (up from 10) and there remain 107 sites using a partial outsource model, where some or all of the radiologist services are performed through a private partnership.

### Radiology reporting

#### Reporting rates

The average reporting rate (percentage of examinations reported) has increased to 99% and continues to be above the 90% target<sup>8</sup> for all but 1 facility. Doomadgee in North West HHS had a reporting rate of 88% (this is down from a 100% reporting rate in 2015-16).

Table 5 shows a four year comparison by HHS of reporting rate and the percentage of those reports available within 24 hours (<24hr rate). A three year comparison by facility is provided in Appendix 7.

### Report turnaround times

The Guideline for the Provision of diagnostic imaging reports<sup>9</sup> includes a requirement for each HHS to have a local procedure for monitoring report turnaround times.

The percentage of reports available within 24 hours was provided by 119 of the 128 sites that performed examinations and is included in Table 5. Note the wide variation (16%-97%) across the HHSs. The clinical appropriateness of the report turnaround time should be determined by the individual HHS to ensure that timeframes are relevant to the facility, patient type and modality.

### Report provider

15 of the 16 HHSs utilise a private partnership for some or all of their radiology reporting (down from 16 in 2015-16). The percentage of outsourced reports has decreased from 44% in 2015-16 to 42% in 2016-17. 389,089 (40%) of outsourced reports were delivered to QH facilities electronically via the External Radiology Reporting Interface (ERRI).<sup>10,11</sup> This represents a decrease of 4% on the 2015-16 financial year when 406,077 reports were delivered via ERRI.

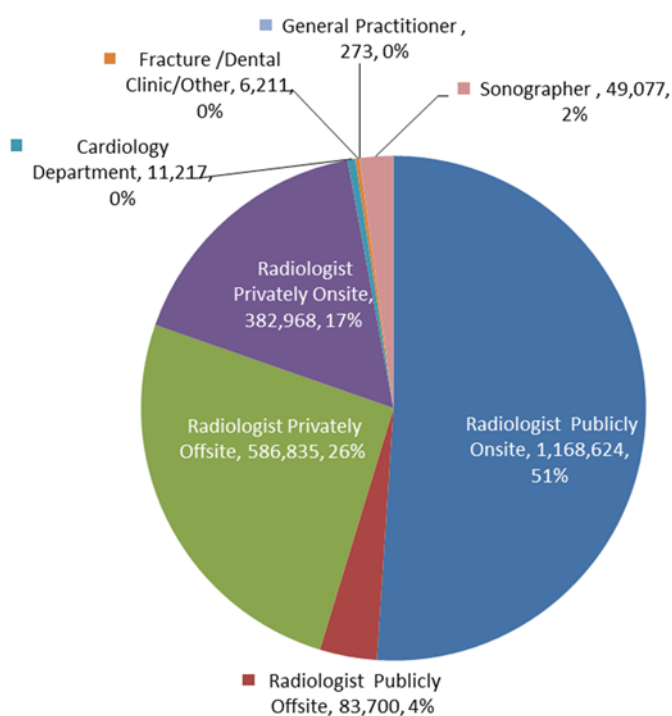


Figure 4 Report provider

Figure 4 and Table 6 provide a summary of the reporting providers utilised by the HHSs and the Mater Public Hospital.

## Workforce

Between 2015-16 and 2016-17, the number of funded FTEs<sup>12</sup> increased by 11.2% from 1,648 to 1,833. Some HHSs experienced a significant change in FTE. West Moreton HHS saw a 22% increase in their total FTE while Sunshine Coast HHS increased their FTE by 67% - an explanation for this change is detailed below:

Within Sunshine Coast HHS there were significant changes at all sites with the opening of the Sunshine Coast University Hospital (SCUH):

- SCUH opened on the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2017. The medical imaging department at SCUH is staffed by 146.85 FTE positions.
- CT services at Caloundra ceased on the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017. The CT scanner was decommissioned on this date and then moved to Gympie.
- CT services commenced at Gympie on the 15<sup>th</sup> May 2017. New positions were created to establish a CT service at Gympie.
- Ultrasound services at Caloundra ceased on the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017.
- Staff working at Caloundra were re-deployed elsewhere within the HHS as of the 29<sup>th</sup> March, and the radiographer working at Caloundra is now rostered from the pool of radiographers employed at SCUH.
- On the 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017, services and staff numbers were reduced at Nambour due to the opening of SCUH.

Workforce data by facility is provided in Appendix 9.

## Vacancies

The total vacancy rate across all sites surveyed has increased from 4.6% in 2015-16 to 4.8% in 2016-17, and the unfilled vacancy rate has increased from 2.6% to 3%. A vacancy is regarded as a funded FTE (or part thereof) where the occupant has resigned and left the organisation permanently. A breakdown of backfilled and unfilled vacancies by HHS is included in Table 7.

## X-ray operators

The number of x-ray operators has increased slightly from 330 in 2015-16 to 333 in 2016-17. X-ray operators provide general x-ray services (or support a sole radiographer) at 91 rural and remote facilities. See Appendix 10 for a detailed breakdown of x-ray operator numbers (including trainees).

## Sonographers

The vacancy rate for sonographers and radiographers/sonographers has decreased from 11.3% in 2015-16 to 10.3% in 2016-17. This remains as the highest vacancy rate of the professional groups in medical imaging. A breakdown by HHS is provided in Table 10.

Table 11 details the number of FTE dedicated to ultrasound from the combined pool of sonographers and radiographer/sonographers. This data was collected for the first time in 2014-15. Comparisons to the data obtained last year demonstrate that the total pool of sonographers and radiographer/sonographers has increased (from 155 to 178, 15% increase). At the same time, the ultrasound FTE has increased from 112.5 to 123 which corresponds to a 9.3% increase.

Logan have noted that although they appear to have a workforce that work in ultrasound 55% of the time, they currently have four staff on maternity leave or returning from maternity leave and working part-time. Their remaining sonographers are therefore working in ultrasound 85% of the time, in order to meet the demand for ultrasound services.

The ultrasound workforce is predominantly employed within normal business hours, with 90% of ultrasound staff rostered to work within normal business hours (up from 88.5% in 2015-16).

Significant variation is seen between the HHSs in regard to the percentage of the ultrasound workforce's time that is dedicated to ultrasound (percentages range from 33% in South West HHS to 100% in Townsville HHS).

## Appointment waiting times

In 2016-17, the average number of business days to the next available appointment increased across all modalities, except Angiography / Interventional:

- CT increased from 5 to 7 days
- Fluoroscopy increased from 7 to 10 days
- MRI increased from 19 to 24 days
- Ultrasound (excluding obstetrics) increased from 9 to 10 days

## Data quality

Data is recorded as provided on the data collection sheet submitted by each medical imaging site. Comparisons between years are difficult as some data was not provided this year or in previous years. To provide a metric for completeness a score was allocated to the following categories, based on the data provided by each site –

**Examinations** – Score 0 for no details, 0.5 if examination breakdown by (i) modality and (ii) patient type provided, 1 if breakdown provided and totals in sections A and B match.

**Attendance** – Score 0 for no details, 0.5 if attendance breakdown by (i) modality and (ii) patient type provided, 1 if breakdown provided and totals in sections A and B match.

**Reports** – Score 0 for no reporting details, 0.5 if report totals provided, 1 if total for reporting breakdown by type agrees with total for reporting turnaround time.

**Workforce** – Score 0 for no workforce details (total of XO and FTE), Score 1 if total is greater than 0.

**Wait times** – Score 0 for no wait time details (for sites with CSCF greater than 3), Score 1 if total wait time is greater than 0 or if CSCF level is 3 or less.

**Equipment** – Score 0 for no equipment unit details. Score 1 if total is greater than 0.

Table 14 demonstrates the average quality of all results, compared to previous years.
