This letter is to provide corrections to information provided at the ATO's appearance before the Standing Committee on Tax and Revenue on 30 November 2016. I refer to information provided on page 11 and page 14 of the Hansard.

1. In response to a question asked by Ms Butler regarding the Western Australian bill, I (Andrew Mills) advised that "it was perhaps August when it was finally introduced formally". I would like to note a correction for the record. The bill was introduced into WA Parliament on 7 May 2015.
2. In response to a question asked by Ms Butler regarding tax gap, I (Jeremy Hirschhorn) advised that "No. The unpublished gaps have not gone to the minister's office". I would like to note a correction for the record. I have subsequently become aware that a brief that included unpublished initial gap estimates was provided to the Minister's office.
3. In response to a question asked by Mr Hogan regarding our small business fix-it squads, I (Steve Vesperman) advised that "We have actually had 28 fix-it squads across a whole range of particular areas". I would like to note a correction for the record. We had a 5 fix-it squads, with 28 recommendations of which 21 have already been implemented.
