I have only recently come to the realisation that my employer is not paying myself or any of my co-workers any super at all. This is highly disappointing as I believe that if you own a business and willingly hire staff that you should follow all the correct procedures to pay them the correct level of pay and extra entitlements and deductions that are required. There are no current contracts in place for any of the workers either. We are all casual workers which is very annoying as we have no sick pay or holiday pay, so we are required to work unwell otherwise we will not have money to make day to day expenses, unless we save all our money there is no chance of going on holidays with our family unless we wish to sacrifice some other living expenses. I can't speak for my other co-workers but I personally only receive \$20 per hour and work approximately 20 hours per week, I personally believe that is not enough to comfortably afford the living expenses of a single parent family.
