Our school website did not reflect our results because we have undergone gentrification in the last few years and we have almost 2 different schools in the upper and lower years of our very popular school.

Most of my working life has been spent in 'hard' schools and I believe that these schools don't need any more bad publicity. There is already enough accountability in our system. Using NAPLAN to further 'put down' a school community has no value because it is a picture of one week of the year in a student's educational journey.
