The National Capital Committee will question the National Capital Authority (NCA) at its biannual public hearing on Thursday, 17 July 2014 from 10:00 am to 11 am in **Committee Room 1R2**, Parliament House, Canberra.

The NCA manages the Commonwealth's interest in the planning and development of Canberra and the Territory by administering the National Capital Plan and areas designated as National Lands.

The hearings are a means of raising the level of transparency and parliamentary accountability applying to the NCA.

This hearing will provide an opportunity for the Committee to ask the NCA about recent developments and plans for the National Capital, including the status of current and proposed works.

Committee Chair, Luke Simpkins MP, noted that "the Committee appreciates the opportunity to have these biannual hearings because we get to discuss a range of issues affecting the Capital and be kept informed on all the latest developments."
