Dear Senator Whish-Wilson

Thank you for your letter of 22 June 2017 concerning the NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) Fisheries surveys on community views on the trial of shark control measures in northern NSW.

A survey undertaken in October/November 2016 was part of a before and after survey around the deployment of the mesh nets in northern NSW in early December 2016. The community survey consisted of a random and representative telephone survey of residents in the Ballina Shire Local Government Area (LGA) and Evans Head. There was also an online survey which could be completed by anyone wanting to contribute their views. Jetty Research was commissioned by DPI to assist with the development of survey questions and to conduct the phone surveys.

Part of the pre-deployment survey was designed to ask locals in the Ballina and Evans areas at which beaches they would like to see the five nets deployed. Based on the responses to this question nets were deployed at Seven Mile Beach, Lennox Head, Sharpes, Shelly and Lighthouse beaches, Ballina, and Main Beach, Evans Head. The remainder of the survey was used to provide data to inform a specific research objective in the NSW North Coast Shark Meshing Trial Management Plan, to "monitor the level of community acceptance to the presence and operation of the nets during the trial."

I have attached a copy of the survey questions as requested. However, the data collected from the surveys is currently being analysed and will be provided in the Management Plan report. Release of the data prior to full analysis and interpretation is not possible.


View the Shark net trial facts below before moving on to further questions.

- Shark nets do not create an enclosed area or provide a barrier between people and sharks
- Shark nets are designed to catch potentially dangerous sharks which are in the area or moving through while feeding on bait fish
- n an attempt to minimise harm to other marine life Shark nets are fitted with 'whale alarms' and 'dolphin pingers' NSW DP will trial other means to minimise harm however due to the nature of the nets other animals may be affected
