To the Senate Committee,

I fully support any Bill requiring mandatory labelling of palm oil in food, as I believe consumers should be able to choose to avoid palm oil because of the environmental issues associated with it. Currently it is very difficult for consumers to be able to make such an informed choice as palm oil is often labelled as simply being vegetable oil.
