**Mr Templeman asked:**

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** In my electorate, we have a region called Grose Vale, and premises in Grose Vale are not due to be connected until April to June next year. Is that the latest, or will properties still be awaiting connection later into 2021?

**Ms Dyer:** I'm not across Grose Vale as a specific area, but I'd be more than happy to look at that. It's just that I'd prefer to look at it in detail and come back to you.

**Ms TEMPLEMAN:** Sure, I would appreciate that. Can you confirm that some premises will be waiting until 2022, based on your predictions?

**Ms Dyer:** Unfortunately, at this stage, the only premises that we are forecasting to go outside of this financial year—that is, past June 2021—are the two areas in Parramatta.

**Answer:**

As of December 2020, premises in the general locality of Grose Vale are estimated for Ready to Connect between April-Jun 2021. NBN Co will continue to explore opportunities to bring this date forward.
