Dear Parliamentary Inquiry

**Re: Inquiry: The deployment, adoption and application of 5G in Australia.**

From my study of the literature, I believe that there is still quite insufficient scientific evidence of the safety of 5G technology and I believe that rolling out 5G before proper research into its affects on the health of Australians is an unwelcome form of experimentation on the population. An independent scientific opinion on the safety of this new technology should be obtained from the Inquiry before proceeding with deployment.

The amount of money needed to employ 5G is not justified under these circumstances and particularly with 4G already doing a good job in providing internet services.

In addition, in my work I have noticed that there are a significant number of individuals you are sensitive to electromagnetic radiation. Such individuals need to have their rights protected so that they can avoid having 5G or similar technologies installed near their homes. Currently there appears to be no available mechanism to appeal decisions to install devices near their premises.
