On notice, for each of the departments, I ask that you provide to the committee the notebooks of officials that have attended insofar as there are notes relating to electric vehicles. ANSWER:

At the time of the Ministerial Forum on Vehicle Emissions meetings in 2016, the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (DIIS) had portfolio representation on the Forum through its energy policy responsibilities (represented by the Minister for Resources, Energy and Northern Australia). Following the 2016 election, responsibility for energy policy moved to the environment portfolio (represented by the Minister for Environment and Energy). The Department of the Environment and Energy will answer this question on behalf of their current officials. One official who is now within DIIS attended several meetings but has no notes relating to electric vehicles.
