The Senate Community Affairs References Committee has extended the date for submissions to its inquiry into investigations into a possible cancer cluster on the Bellarine Peninsula in Victoria to **27 March 2020**.

'The committee is seeking submissions from a wide range of people, including from residents in the Bellarine area,' said the Committee Chair, Senator Rachel Siewert.

'The committee wants to ensure that people have enough time to prepare their submissions so we have extended the date', Senator Siewert said. 'If you cannot get your submission to the committee by this date, please contact the secretariat,' Senator Siewert said.

Inquiry Terms of Reference

Investigations into a possible cancer cluster on the Bellarine Peninsula, Victoria, with particular reference to:

- (a) the health concerns of local residents;
- (b) the incidence of cancer cases in the area, and any possible environmental or other contributing factors;
- (c) the evidence, approach and outcomes concerning the Victorian Chief Health Officer's investigation of cancer rates on the Bellarine Peninsula; and
- (d) any other related matter.

Public hearings

The committee plans to travel to the Bellarine Peninsula to hold a public hearing on **1 May 2020**, to hear first-hand from residents and gain an understanding of the context in which these concerns have arisen.

The times and venue for the committee's hearing will be published on the inquiry website.
