

The latest bill introduced by the parliament of Australia waiting Royal consent is The VISA CAPPING BILL . This bill is against the basic human rights.

The case: Australia opened its borders in early mid nineties to foreign students . The Australian economy was not in a proper shape and it had to organize Sydney Olympics for which the country required manpower and money.
