

With regards to this decision, the following implications are imminent not only for the immigrants but also for those who are and will contribute to the Australian educational system and the economy as a whole:

The families of those studying here will have to undergo extreme emotional stress of sudden uncertainty and putting them at an undue risk of starting from scratch.

The students who were competent and wanted to contribute to the economy of Australia after being educated as per the Australian standards, will be denied their human and fundamental rights.

Future students who want to join Australian universities would be forced to consider the government policies unjustified and against students setting a wrong example w.r.t. the govt for them.

This step would give immense encouragement to immigration “ in the form of refugees “ because that would possibly be the easiest way acceptable by the Australian govt, depreciating the image of the country and its citizens in the world.

The govt must make an honest effort to take responsibility for its earlier immigration policies because of which this situation has arisen and try to take decisions respecting and considering the public opinion in this matter.
