Call for submissions

The Senate Education and Employment Legislation Committee is calling for submissions to its inquiry into the provisions of the Jobs and Skills Australia Bill 2022 by 23 September 2022.

The bill seeks to establish a new statutory agency—Jobs and Skills Australia—to provide advice on current and emerging skills and training needs of workers and employers.

The committee's inquiry will also address the provisions of the associated Jobs and Skills Australia (National Skills Commissioner Repeal) Bill 2022, which repeals the *National Skills Commissioner Act 2020*.
