Question:

How many people have been receiving each social security payment (including JobSeeker Payment and Youth Allowance), and how many applications for each payment have been on hand, in each week since the beginning of March, Including:

- a. Indicating the number of payment recipients receiving the Coronavirus Supplement
- b. Total number of payments by payment type and gender
- c. Total number of payments by payment type and recipient age cohort
- d. Total number of payments by payment type and location (state/territory, Commonwealth Electoral Division (CED), and Local Government Area (LGA))
- e. Please provide the committee with a weekly update of these figures – similar to the table provided at the hearing on 30 April.

Data Descriptions/Notes- Table 1:

* Recipients of Newstart Allowance and Jobseeker Payment prior to 29 May 2020 included recipients of Bereavement Allowance and Sickness Allowance as these payments have been subsumed into JobSeeker Payment. This allowed for a better comparison between the recipient numbers. Recipients of Bereavement Allowance and Sickness Allowance recipients are no longer included in this data since 29 May 2020, due to the small number of recipients and subsequent risk of identification of individuals if combined with other publicly available data.

[^] Claims on hand, includes legacy claims for Newstart Allowance, Bereavement Allowance and Sickness Allowance.

Recipients of JobSeeker Payment/Newstart Allowance/Sickness Allowance who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system and not in receipt of a zero rate of payment.

Recipients of Bereavement Allowance/Youth Allowance (other) who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system.

[#] From 3 July 2020, legacy claims on hand for Newstart Allowance, Bereavement Allowance and Sickness Allowance are included in claims on hand for JobSeeker Payment.

Note: From 20 March 2020, JobSeeker Payment replaced Newstart Allowance as the main income support payment for recipients aged between 22 years to Age Pension qualification age who have capacity to work. Bereavement Allowance closed to new entrants and will cease when all current recipients have completed their bereavement period. Sickness Allowance closed to new entrants and will cease on 20 September 2020.

Note: Newstart Allowance (including Bereavement Allowance and Sickness Allowance) claims reflect claim activities lodged prior to the introduction of JobSeeker Payment on 20 March 2020. Where an outstanding Newstart Allowance, claim is granted, the recipient will instead transfer to JobSeeker Payment.
