As a Donor Mum, I plead with you not to interfere with existing regulations concerning written contact and social media interactions between Donor Family and Recipient.

If you are NOT a Donor Mum or Dad, you have NO understanding how we feel with the loss of our child, and then donation of their organs.

I grieve the loss of my son, [REDACTED], 6 years ago. I rejoice in the comfort of knowing he was able to give 6 people a second chance in life.

I receive cards every anniversary and Christmas, telling me how they are going, and the milestones they can now achieve through Donation, and they are forever grateful.

Change the law, and these recipients would be lost forever.

Every Anniversary becomes harder, knowing my son is gone, although he is still walking around in his recipients.

[REDACTED] was passionate about Organ Donation, and we upheld his wish to help others.

If all contact, by a new law, is to be taken away, I, my family and friends, will withdraw our registration, thus denying the many people, including babies (one was a 2 month old baby boy) from receiving a precious organ, and a chance for a healthy life. PLEASE, take a walk in our shoes, learn of the comfort we receive in communications, and how Social media enables us to share our grief with others who understand.
