1.	Senator Kim Carr (p. 5)	<p>Senator KIM CARR: What do you think the difference is in unit cost production between a conventional vehicle and an electric vehicle? Have you got any idea what that is?</p> <p>Mr McLean: I won't give you figures off the top of my head. I don't have the exact ones to hand, but I'm happy to take that question on notice and come back to you.</p> <p>Senator KIM CARR: Does Mitsubishi? You're in both fields. You produce both electric vehicles and conventional vehicles. Do you have any understanding of the unit cost difference?</p> <p>Mr Gehling: I don't have any figures I could provide you with now.</p> <p>Senator KIM CARR: Can you provide that to the committee?</p> <p>Mr Gehling: I'll ask and see if we can provide some information.</p>

Response to Question 1

Mitsubishi Motors Australia cannot provide unit costs on specific models as this information is commercial-in-confidence. We can provide the relative recommended retail costs difference which based on similar but not identical specification models, is approximately \$8000, when comparing the Outlander Exceed AWD diesel to the Outlander Exceed AWD PHEV.
