I wish to correct evidence provided during the Australian National Audit Office's appearance before the Parliamentary Joint Committee on the Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity hearing for the inquiry into the Integrity of Australia's border arrangements on 11 September 2020.

On Page 9 of the Transcript for the hearing I stated that:

What we do know is that they did have a form of efficiency measure in there for the assessments process that ACLEI undertook and the timeliness of that assessments process, and they had a target of <u>90 per cent within 75 days</u>.

As outlined in paragraph 2.4 and Figure 2.1 of Auditor-General report No. 4 (2018-19) <u>Operational</u> <u>Efficiency of the Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity</u> the ACLEI target is <u>75 per cent of assessments within 90 days.</u>
