

Question on Notice from the public hearing in Wollongong on 1 April 2016, where Mr Tom Matinca gave evidence.

The question was put by Senator Lambie:

Regarding the cost and process involved in running an anti-dumping case, what is the initial cost for the application form, to go in and start the whole process? Does it go to the government first, or elsewhere? What is the cost figure we are looking at?

Answer:

In looking back through the records we have, we cannot find any amounts paid to “the government” or ADC to start the process.
