

**I support the Health Insurance Amendment
(Medicare Funding for Certain Types of Abortion) Bill 2013**

A recent Galaxy poll in Tasmania 9 February 2013 showed that 92% of people opposed gender selected abortion. The United Nations condemned gender selected abortion in a 2011 report as 'gender discrimination against girls and women and a violation of their human rights.'
