To the Senate Standing Committee on Education and Employment,

Thankyou to the Chair and Senators on this Committee for making time on 12 November to hear witness testimony from members of the ANU Governance Project.

I write to correct two inadvertent errors in my evidence.

1. During the hearing, I said that ‘ANU has announced that they already meet those recommendations’, referring to the Senate Inquiry’s recommendations in the Interim Report.

Please may I revise my testimony to state that ANU has announced that it already meets ‘a number’ of the Senate Inquiry's recommendations in the Interim Report.

This minor correction does not change my substantive assessment that ‘if you’re asking whether the work that is being done so constructively here in the Committee would have prevented the crisis at the ANU, the answer would have to be no.’

2. I also said that the ANU Governance Project had requested approximately \$130,000 from the ANU to support a First Nations governance pathway – but that I would need to double check this figure. I can now confirm that this figure was based on an earlier draft - the correct figure we formally requested in financial support for this pathway was \$104,800. Please could this correction be made to my evidence.
